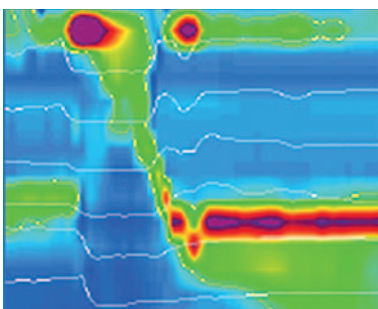


ADVANCED MASTER OF DEGLUTOLOGY



As the prevalence of dysphagia increases as a result of improved survival rates following medical care as well as the ageing population worldwide, so does the demand for academic, medically-trained staff who can care for the needs of patients with swallowing disorders. Therefore, the Faculty of Medicine has established the Master of Deglutology; the first programme of its kind in the world. This advanced master's programme aims to train you as a competent professional in deglutology, the science of deglutition. The programme's focus combines theoretical depth with evidence-based training in the field of swallowing in the oral cavity, throat and oesophagus. You will be trained extensively in clinical diagnostic and therapeutic practice as well as research skills related to the emerging and quickly expanding field of deglutology.

Interdisciplinary programme

This programme was developed in collaboration between KU Leuven Faculty of Medicine, University Hospitals Leuven and several international experts, bringing together complementary expertise from diverse domains. Today, dysphagia patients are cared for by a number of different medical and paramedical disciplines, but there is a clear lack of a specialist who successfully integrates the different aspects of care in the dysphagia patient. This lack comes at a high human as well as proven socio-economic cost. As a deglutologist, you will become this specialist through theoretical, evidence-based training in the interdisciplinary domain of deglutology - for both oropharyngeal and oesophageal dysphagia. You will receive an enhanced clinical training of diagnostic skills and therapeutic interventions at our JCI-accredited University Hospitals Leuven. In addition, you will be taught management skills and you participate in state-of-the-art research projects as part of the deglutology research group of the Department of Neurosciences, Experimental ORL and Translational Research Centre for Gastrointestinal Disease (TARGID) KU Leuven.

Your profile

The programme is intended for candidates or professionals who hold a

1. Master's degree in medicine, speech pathology, dentistry, physiotherapy or occupational therapy. All other health-related master's degrees will be carefully considered and evaluated per individual request.
2. 4-year or 5-year university bachelor's degree in speech pathology, physiotherapy, occupational therapy or dentistry with access to higher degree education (e.g. honours programme providing access to PhD).

Admission requirements

To be eligible for the Master of Deglutology, you must have obtained a degree from an accredited university programme as described above. Thorough knowledge of English is essential. Unless your mother tongue is English, you will be asked to submit a TOEFL or IELTS certificate. If you have already completed a higher education programme in English, your degree will be accepted as sufficient evidence of your English proficiency. Please visit our website for more details.
